August Session Highlights

- ◆ The Rev. Neeley Rentz Lane reported that the Anti-Racism Task Force started meeting last week and have a few things to pursue. They are asking for prayers for direction and support from the congregation.
- The yard signs are a big hit and there are still some left at the church for members who did not receive one.
- Motion from Facilities and Equipment Committee to sell the Covington First Presbyterian Church van to Ginn Motors for \$2000.00 was approved.
- Facilities and Equipment reported on damage to church roof and HVAC units from hail storm and are still working toward repairs with adjusters and contractors.
- ◆ Finance committee reported that as of the end of July the revenue to expense is at a -\$7876.36.
- Motion to obtain a phone system and enter into contract agreement with Mitel for the service was approved.
- Doug Bolton reported that the See and Serve drive garnered a total of \$1675.00 in donations with Baby Love receiving \$20.00, Sandwich/Snack (YMCA) program \$225.00, School Supplies \$25.00, Family Promise \$835.00 and the Food Pantry \$570.00.
- Witness committee stated Meals on Wheels is coming up on August 29th and still need volunteers.


Great FPC Covington Bake Off
