The Congregational Life & Care team reported that on December 15th the Christmas Joy Lunch will be served after morning worship.

There will be an Estate Sale at the home of our beloved Joyce Ashworth on December 12 - 14.

The Facilities & Equipment committee reported that the parking lot agreement with Covington-Newton County Chamber of Commerce was signed, the HVAC unit for the sanctuary was repaired, and a there was a \$10k reduction in price of the roof installation.

A Motion from the Facilities & Equipment Committee to approve the use of the Jubilee room for an exclusive Men's Bible Study group was approved.

The Finance & Stewardship committee reported that FPC has \$313,000.00 pledged so far from 61 families and that we are tracking ahead of last year's pledges. They will be performing a church audit in January.

The Welcoming & Evangelism team reported the status of new visitors and encouraged Session as well as congregation members to reach out to new faces weekly.

The Witness team reported that FPC was well represented at the Family Promise Gala and estimated that members of our church donated ~\$4000.00 for the event. They also reported that 4 of the families FPC hosted in February for Family Promise now have a home.



Christmas Joy Lunch


